## Shutesbury School Committee- December 15, 2016 Final Minutes

PRESENT: Fred Steinberg, Chair; Dan Hayes, Katie Fiander and Lauren Thomas-Paquin, members; Jackie Mendonsa, Principal; Jennifer Haggerty, Superintendent; Stephen Cass, Interim Director of Finance and Operations; public.

- called to order by Fred Steinberg at 7:05pm
- perpetual calendar: Our Town submission due January
  - Fred will write, Jen Haggerty will write a Union 28 submission
- no gifts or warrants
- Minutes from last month: motion to approve by Dan Hayes, seconded by Katie
  - approved unanimously
- Public comments: acknowledgment of former student Joey Pearson who died suddenly over the weekend.
- New Business:
  - Resolution in Support of Rural Schools
    - proposal to establish rural school aid
    - work from rural Superintendents group
    - three votes-
      - resolution
        - Katie made motion to support the resolution to support MA rural schools, Fred seconded
        - unanimously approved
      - join MA Rural Schools Coalition
        - Dan made motion for Shutesbury School Committee to join, seconded by Katie
        - unanimously supported
      - to support Massachusetts rural school aid support
        - Dan made motion to approve, seconded by Fred
        - unanimously supported
- Finance and Operations:
  - lost K grant, other grants gained= wash
  - no immediate needs
  - addition of \$10,000 for nurse sub
  - buffer
  - next year's budget
    - cost of living adjustments for administration
    - in FY17 it looked like we were spending less on salaries because grants were included.
      - Grants have been moved to a separate line and actual costs are listed.
      - Similar changes for sped director's salary
      - curriculum coordinator is being paid for in the U28 budget this year
        - U28 PD money paying for curriculum coordinator instead of grants
          - Dan suggested creating a driver page to explain these notable changes to the budget
            - re-crafting the budget for greater transparency
      - Other School Services- lines 67-72 cost of living increase
      - 1.28% increase
      - substitute teacher rate increase is not reflected in this budget
        - SC has not voted as we have not seen the budgetary impact to a rate increase

- Dan brought up the tax impact of our budget, suggested making clear to the community money that has been returned to the town.
- School Choice money \$10,000 is not recorded in the budget
  - used for extras as needed, not for funding budget
  - Jackie explained that the school has a list of wants and needs such as replacing the curtain and getting a laptop cart
- Dan will provide information he received at a conference about bidding to Jackie and Jen
- Renee to discuss contract negotiations
  - scheduling negotiations meetings
    - preliminary meeting to set up a number of meetings as well as dates and times, notify SC
      - January 5<sup>th</sup> at 5:30
- Nurse position-- Jackie interviewing
  - candidates not meeting criteria for school nurse certification
  - excellent substitute who isn't interested in permanent position
- Policies:
  - IHAMB- policy edit
  - JICH- Alcohol, Tobacco and Drug Use for Students Policy
  - Dan moves to approve KFR- Community Use of Facilities, Fred seconds
    - approved unanimously
  - Dan moves to approve KHC- Notice Distribution Policy, Fred seconds
    - approved unanimously
- Reports
  - Principal Report
    - circus exhibition tomorrow unless school is cancelled, then it would be rescheduled for January
      - not typical Artists in Residence show
      - more an exhibition of skills
      - bake sale and raffle by PTO
      - Building Committee decided to make repairs to the roof
        - priorities- boiler, tiles for rooms, and sidewalks
      - Chief Harding got a grant for security updates like fobs and wiring
        - o doesn't fund a surveillance camera for the front door
          - could be paid for with budget
          - hopeful that town will support if school can't fund it
  - Superintendent's Report
    - U28 strategic plan draft to be shared January
    - new Superintendent induction program
      - sustaining effective leadership team
      - tools for monitoring work
      - consultancy protocol
    - met with leadership team on ed evaluation goals
    - U28 schools participated in Monte's March in November, Jennifer walked with 6<sup>th</sup> grade
      - raised over \$600, food drive
  - Dan appreciated Jen's participation, asked that it be shared on Collaborative FB page
